The Seniors Place, which will be changing its name to Amazing Place at this special fundraising event, is a memory care day center for people with early to moderate memory loss. Celebrating its 13th year of service, the center has outgrown its current facility at 2714 Joanel in the River Oaks area and has broken ground on a new, larger center at 3735 Drexel between I-59 and Richmond that will allow the program to serve three times more participants.

The Seasons of Change Luncheon is the organization's sole fundraising event, and co-chairs Liz Rigney and Nancy Elizabeth Garfield hope to raise \$210,000. An educational forum focusing on key issues and concerns of those with memory loss and their caregivers will begin at 10 a.m. and is free and open to the public. The forum features Mary Kenan Owens Psy.D, and Paul Schulz M.D, both with the department of neurology at Baylor College of Medicine. The luncheon follows at noon.
