Dear Friends,

Amazing Place exists to help our neighbors live to their full potential with hope and purpose. Our mission goes beyond a dementia diagnosis, caregiver challenges or memory preservation. We actively collaborate with our community so that those in need know they are not alone and that every day presents new opportunities for which to be thankful.

In a year sparked with exciting new brain health research, 2023 was, by any measure, one of our organization's most successful years ever. A strategic planning process was undertaken to provide a road map for the future and we updated our mission statement to address brain health education.

Our **Cuidando con Respeto**, the area's first Spanish language dementia caregiver education program, was widely embraced in the community as we expanded and created additional caregiver offerings. We also added new **Brain Health Matters** topics which were presented free of charge and toward the end of the year we began planning for a new offering, **Cognitive Stimulation Therapy**, for those newly diagnosed with Mild Cognitive Impairment.

Of course, one of 2023's highlights was breaking ground on our second campus, **Amazing Place West**, last November in Katy. Thanks to the research, planning, fundraising and faith of so many over the last few years, we anticipate moving into this new 19,000 square foot facility in the Spring of 2025. We are incredibly excited and grateful.

Our ability to expand our programs and continue offering many services at little to no cost was made possible due to the extraordinary generosity of our philanthropic community. Amazing Place had a record-breaking operational fundraising year because individuals, foundations, companies, and faith communities across our community believe in our vital and unique mission. These gifts allow us to keep **Day Program** tuition reasonable and offer dementia caregivers and our community innovative programming to educate, support, and empower those in need.

In the face of dementia, we applaud all the heroes in our Amazing Place family who refuse to give up, and refuse to give in. Thank you for believing in what is possible.

ENGAGING THOSE DIAGNOSED

For those with mild to moderate dementia, our comprehensive Day Program continued to provide a happy, nurturing environment to engage with others through a purpose-filled calendar of activities.

Welcoming our **Day Program** participants each morning and seeing their faces light up as they share stories and engage in new and old skills — from the arts to games to exercise — reminds us daily of the bravery and resilience these individuals possess. It’s clear their God-given personalities and talents deserve our love and respect.

2023 participants were involved in evidence-based creative, cultural, social, spiritual, nutritional and physical activities as well as entertaining cognitive therapies to keep them challenged at their highest level. Our on-site Health, Family and Culinary teams ensured our Day Program families were fully supported by trained and dedicated professionals. Last year, we reinstated our community outings to explore the world around us, embraced special performances by the Houston Symphony and others, and hosted special events including a holiday market.

Last year we began planning the 2024 roll-out of a new small group offering, **Cognitive Stimulation Therapy (CST)** for those

individuals with Mild Cognitive Impairment (MCI). Considered to be a stage sometimes leading to dementia, MCI

can be characterized by memory impairment but also by difficulty with language, thinking speed, visuospatial skills, problem-solving, or attention. Our newest evidence-based offering has been found to show improvements in cognitive function, mood, communication, social engagement and overall quality of life for participants and caregivers alike.

EMPOWERING FAMILY AND FRIENDS

We continued to empower the real heroes of the dementia journey — caregiving families and friends.

Even as our Day Program provided a reliable and safe environment for participants last year, we made new strides in empowering the real heroes of the dementia journey — family caregivers and the friends who support those struggling with cognitive decline. While continuing to offer free next-step advice, support groups, counseling, and care navigation, we doubled-down last year on delivering innovative caregiver programs acknowledged nationally by dementia experts as leading the way in behavioral support.

2023 Highlights

We expanded our Spanish-language caregiver program, **Cuidando con Respeto**, in 2023 and found that in an area where 44% of the population is Spanish speaking, we filled a huge gap in dementia education. Working in partnership with churches and volunteers from congregations as well as our Cuidando con Respeto Advisory Group, we made significant progress in serving a population needing culturally appropriate expertise to improve the quality of dementia-touched lives.

Caregivers Connect! was created and launched by our Caregiver Programs Director Sharon Cantrell in 2023 when she realized that those taking our **Savvy Caregiver**® classes were longing for additional conversations with their peers on topics specific to their dementia caregiver experiences. The periodic informal gatherings are filled with laughter as these courageous individuals share their personal stories and learn from each other and our Amazing Place experts. Topics covered in last year's sessions included *Good Grief!*, *Magic Words to Decrease Dementia Resistance*, and *I Need a Break!*

STAR-C Caregiver is a pilot program that is unique in its use of trained volunteers to provide one-to-one in-home support and training to family caregivers. This offering personalizes what caregivers have learned in a classroom setting while bringing volunteerism to a new level of compassionate need. Last year we more than doubled the number of caregivers enrolled in STAR-C and trained eight new volunteer consultants to support this program.

ADVANCING BRAIN HEALTH

40 percent of dementia cases can be prevented by lifestyle interventions.

This astonishing statistic reinforced the need last year for Amazing Place to help increase awareness of the importance of brain health and advocating for personal lifestyle behaviors resulting in a longer, healthier and more productive life. We believe that every individual should be the champion of their own health.

Our well-established **Brain Health Matters** presentations as well as **Memory Enhancement Training** and **Aging Solo** classes were as popular as ever as we added new topics and promoted lifestyle changes via social media. We reached out to organizations in need of speakers and we intentionally sought out healthcare providers to understand their patients' needs to determine how our services can complement clinical care.

2023 Highlights

Last year, our dementia experts created a new **Brain Health Matters** presentation, *Navigating Your Aging Roadmap*, based on the success of our popular three-week class **Aging Solo**. We delivered the topic free of charge to groups ranging from YMCAs and community centers to rehab specialists and congregations across Houston. This overview of tools, resources and next-step advice for planning an independent, meaningful life as you age includes tips on building your team, making sure all legal and financial documents are in order and considering health care and end of life decisions as well housing options. Equally popular was the roll out of our new *Practical Tips for a Healthier You* presentation. This topic explores why health span is more important than lifespan and explores the pillars of improved cognitive health — physical and mental exercise, brain-healthy nutrition, sleep, stress reduction and social engagement.

KEEPING THE FAITH

A grant helps to identify parishioners living alone and at risk for dementia and then connect them and their caregivers to church and community resources.

2023 was a year to walk in step with our faith partners. We continued to expand our **Faith Care Connection** program with churches in Houston and Katy, seeking to improve the quality of life for both aging parishioners and their families. We collaborated with pastors and their staff on customized programs to build awareness of dementia within their congregations and to aid them in creating dementia-friendly churches, including training church leaders and volunteers on how to identify and better assist those with cognitive decline. We applaud the heroic efforts of our churches to minister to all those of faith.

2023 Highlight

We established terrific new collaborations with faith partners last year, introducing them to our many programs and partnering with them on specialized offerings. We hosted a well-attended Katy Pastoral Care breakfast at The Fellowship last October

and were welcomed as we shared our history of working in west Houston and the many ways we will bring our new campus to life beginning next year. Also, as **Cuidando con Respeto** gained traction throughout the year with churches with large Spanish speaking populations, we collaborated with many new congregations and even hosted our sessions on Radio Maria, an international Catholic radio broadcasting service.

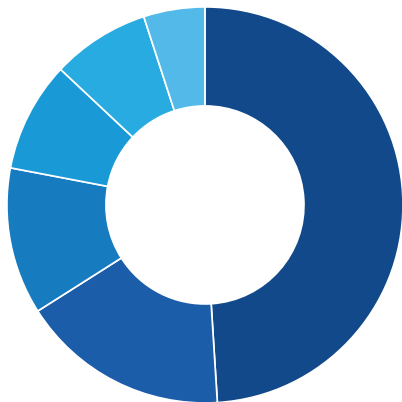
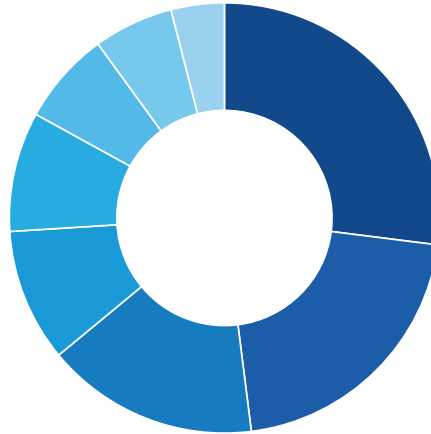


FINANCIAL REPORT

Because of the generosity of our supporters in 2023, our expansion efforts took shape and we were able to add programming to better meet community needs. The cash position of the organization was strong at the end of the year with \$2.2 million in cash and \$6.3 million in restricted cash and investments.
