Are You Interested In One Of The Most Rewarding Volunteer Opportunities In Town?**

WE CURRENTLY NEED:

ART TEACHERS

(Tuesday or Thursday mornings 10:15am - 11:15am)

Volunteers lead and assist small groups in acrylic or watercolor art classes. Artistic ability is helpful. Typically a once a week commitment.

BIBLE STUDY LEADERS

(Weekdays from 1pm - 2:15pm)

Volunteer leaders facilitate a small group Bible study weekly or as available. A class usually consists of a beginning prayer, singing a couple of familiar hymns, a 20-30 minute lesson, concluding with a song or two and a prayer. You do not have to be a Bible scholar at all – just a passionate, energetic volunteer who loves the Lord! We do provide a guideline to assist leaders, but a little advance preparation may be necessary. This is typically a once a week assignment, but we have substitute openings also. (This is a great volunteer opportunity for 2 friends to do together.)

SCRABBLE PLAYERS

(Weekdays 3pm - 4:30pm)

Volunteers facilitate a friendly game of Scrabble each afternoon with a small group of participants. A once a week commitment is helpful.

KITCHEN VOLUNTEERS

(Weekdays from 9:30am - 1pm)

Volunteers will work with our fabulous Chef Michael providing support for our Memory Preservation Nutrition program. This involves lots of fresh food preparation (chopping, baking cookies, making salad dressings) as well as plating food/serving. Typically a once a week assignment from approximately 9:30-10am to 12:30-1pm. Perks include a healthy, yummy lunch and secret tips from the chef.

FRONT DESK VOLUNTEERS

(Regular openings are Mondays or Fridays 11 am - 12pm, 3rd Tuesday of each month 11 am - 12pm, PLUS we typically fill 15 - 20 shifts/month with substitutes)

As the “Face of Amazing Place”, volunteers cheerfully greet participants and caregivers as they arrive and depart; answering and directing calls. We call this position “Command Central” since everything seems to revolve around the front desk. This is a great spot to meet our participants and their family members, as well as our entire staff. The regular shifts are typically a once a week commitment, but monthly emails are sent out with many open shifts for substitutes.
